EASTERN SEWER TRUNK MAIN

WORKS NOTICE

We are writing to let you know about upcoming works as part of the Eastern Sector Sewer Trunk Main project in your area. This notice explains what to expect next and how access and traffic may be affected.

What's next?

Works behind the industrial park near the Wastewater Treatment Plant, and the section through the Aston Hills Golf Course, are now underway.

You may have already noticed:

- A reduced speed limit of 25 km/hr along Parkview Drive, introduced in response to concerns raised by residents
- A laydown yard at the Parkview Drive reserve for storing pipes, materials and equipment. This location was chosen for its proximity to the work zone, reducing transportation times and distances, and subsequently, the overall time spent working in your area. *Please note that the laydown yard is not used during nightworks.*
- A water cart operating regularly to keep dust under control, which will be replaced by a street sweeper during winter to reduce mud on the roads
- Changes to pedestrian paths.

Multiple crews are now being deployed across several work fronts to progress through the Parkview Drive and Bald Hills Road works as quickly as possible.

How this affects you

Here's what to expect:

- **Construction activity:** workers, machinery and vehicles will be active in the area.
- **Traffic and pedestrian management:** traffic and pedestrian controls will be in place, where required, to keep everyone safe. This will include reduced speeds, temporary footpath, lane or road closures, as well as detours. Please follow traffic instructions and take care when moving through the area.
- **Noise, dust, mud:** Some work will create noise, dust, mud or minor vibration. Machinery such as vacuum trucks can be particularly noisy. Dewatering pumps may run overnight at times to help crews start work on time each morning, reducing the overall time spent working in your area. These will be fitted with noise-reduction measures to limit noise as much as possible.

Pipe installation on Parkview Drive will be undertaken via open trenching during day shifts, Monday to Friday, 7:00am–5:00pm.

Due to high traffic volumes, **works on Bald Hills Road will also be carried out during a full road closure at night**, Sunday to Thursday, 7:00 pm – 6:00 am, to ensure the safety of workers and road users. Light vehicles will be detoured via Green Avenue → Tate Avenue and Scarborough Way. Heavy vehicles will not be detoured through residential streets. Bald Hill Road will reopen to traffic during the day. Installations on **Scarborough Way between Parkview Drive and Bald Hills Road will also occur at night.**

Specific impacts and expected timeframes at each location are highlighted in the map overleaf.

Hartmann Road through to Emerald Way will be the last stage of works on this project, with construction expected to begin mid-2026. More information will be provided closer to the start of these works.
